<p>Psalm 91:2</p> <p>I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.</p>	<p>Psalm 91:6</p> <p>Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday.</p>
