

## Where do you find...?

The purpose of this exercise is to help the student remember where things are found in the Bible. Make a copy of the answer sheet for each student. Read the Scripture but not the reference. The student then marks on the answer sheet whether the verse is found in the Old Testament or the New Testament and so on. Four points are possible for each verse if the student can give the full reference.

*Example: The teacher reads— “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.” If the student knows this verse came from the New Testament, he would circle “NT”. On the book line he would write “John”. But if he could not remember the chapter and verse he would leave those lines blank and receive a score of 2 for that verse.*

### **Set 1**

- (1) *Genesis 50:26* So Joseph died, being an hundred and ten years old: and they embalmed him, and he was put in a coffin in Egypt.
- (2) *Acts 2:1* And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.
- (3) *1 Corinthians 13:13* And now abideth faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity.
- (4) *Jonah 1:2* Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and cry against it; for their wickedness is come up before me.
- (5) *John 4:7* There cometh a woman of Samaria to draw water: Jesus saith unto her, Give me to drink.
- (6) *Genesis 7:1* And the LORD said unto Noah, Come thou and all thy house into the ark; for thee have I seen righteous before me in this generation.
- (7) *Psalms 91:1* He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
- (8) *John 1:1* In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- (9) *2 Kings 2:11* And it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, there appeared a chariot of fire, and horses of fire, and parted them both asunder; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven.
- (10) *Psalms 23:1* The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

### **Set 2**

- (1) *John 11:35* Jesus wept.
- (2) *Matthew 1:18* Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost.
- (3) *Genesis 25:29* And Jacob sod pottage: and Esau came from the field, and he was faint:
- (4) *Daniel 3:20* And he commanded the most mighty men that were in his army to bind Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, and to cast them into the burning fiery furnace.
- (5) *1 Thessalonians 5:17* Pray without ceasing.
- (6) *Revelation 22:21* The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen.
- (7) *1 Samuel 17:4* And there went out a champion out of the camp of the Philistines, named Goliath, of Gath, whose height was six cubits and a span.
- (8) *Hebrews 11:1* Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.
- (9) *Genesis 37:3* Now Israel loved Joseph more than all his children, because he was the son of his old age: and he made him a coat of many colours.
- (10) *Romans 8:28* And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

### Set 3

- (1) *1 Corinthians 13:1* Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not charity, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal.
- (2) *John 3:16* For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- (3) *Genesis 22:2* And he said, Take now thy son, thine only son Isaac, whom thou lovest, and get thee into the land of Moriah; and offer him there for a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of.
- (4) *Ruth 1:8* And Naomi said unto her two daughters in law, Go, return each to her mother's house: the LORD deal kindly with you, as ye have dealt with the dead, and with me.
- (5) *Genesis 37:28* Then there passed by Midianites merchantmen; and they drew and lifted up Joseph out of the pit, and sold Joseph to the Ishmeelites for twenty pieces of silver: and they brought Joseph into Egypt.
- (6) *John 5:4* For an angel went down at a certain season into the pool, and troubled the water: whosoever then first after the troubling of the water stepped in was made whole of whatsoever disease he had.
- (7) *1 Corinthians 10:13* There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.
- (8) *Exodus 2:3* And when she could not longer hide him, she took for him an ark of bulrushes, and daubed it with slime and with pitch, and put the child therein; and she laid it in the flags by the river's brink.
- (9) *2 Kings 5:1* Now Naaman, captain of the host of the king of Syria, was a great man with his master, and honourable, because by him the LORD had given deliverance unto Syria: he was also a mighty man in valour, but he was a leper.
- (10) *Psalms 1:1* Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

### Set 4

- (1) *1 Samuel 3:4* That the LORD called Samuel: and he answered, Here am I.
- (2) *Ephesians 6:11* Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.
- (3) *Matthew 25:1* Then shall the kingdom of heaven be likened unto ten virgins, which took their lamps, and went forth to meet the bridegroom.
- (4) *Joshua 6:2* And the LORD said unto Joshua, See, I have given into thine hand Jericho, and the king thereof, and the mighty men of valour.
- (5) *Esther 4:16* Go, gather together all the Jews that are present in Shushan, and fast ye for me, and neither eat nor drink three days, night or day: I also and my maidens will fast likewise; and so will I go in unto the king, which is not according to the law: and if I perish, I perish.
- (6) *Isaiah 53:4* Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.
- (7) *Genesis 1:1* In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.
- (8) *Luke 15:13* And not many days after the younger son gathered all together, and took his journey into a far country, and there wasted his substance with riotous living.
- (9) *Acts 9:4* And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me?
- (10) *Galatians 5:22* But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,

## Set 5

(1) *Judges 7:20* And the three companies blew the trumpets, and brake the pitchers, and held the lamps in their left hands, and the trumpets in their right hands to blow withal: and they cried, The sword of the LORD, and of Gideon.

(2) *1 Kings 17:1* And Elijah the Tishbite, who was of the inhabitants of Gilead, said unto Ahab, As the LORD God of Israel liveth, before whom I stand, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, but according to my word.

(3) *Proverbs 3:5* Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.

(4) *Luke 2:7* And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped him in swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the inn.

(5) *Daniel 6:22* My God hath sent his angel, and hath shut the lions' mouths, that they have not hurt me: forasmuch as before him innocency was found in me; and also before thee, O king, have I done no hurt.

(6) *Acts 16:25* And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them.

(7) *Deuteronomy 5:16* Honour thy father and thy mother, as the LORD thy God hath commanded thee; that thy days may be prolonged, and that it may go well with thee, in the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

(8) *Ruth 4:17* And the women her neighbours gave it a name, saying, There is a son born to Naomi; and they called his name Obed: he is the father of Jesse, the father of David.

(9) *Exodus 20:3* Thou shalt have no other gods before me.

(10) *Genesis 19:26* But his wife looked back from behind him, and she became a pillar of salt.

## Set 6

(1) *John 6:9* There is a lad here, which hath five barley loaves, and two small fishes: but what are they among so many?

(2) *Psalms 119:105* Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.

(3) *Acts 7:59* And they stoned Stephen, calling upon God, and saying, Lord Jesus, receive my spirit.

(4) *2 Kings 6:6* And the man of God said, Where fell it? And he shewed him the place. And he cut down a stick, and cast it in thither; and the iron did swim.

(5) *Exodus 8:5* And the LORD spake unto Moses, Say unto Aaron, Stretch forth thine hand with thy rod over the streams, over the rivers, and over the ponds, and cause frogs to come up upon the land of Egypt.

(6) *Romans 8:28* And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

(7) *Matthew 5:6* Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.

(8) *Genesis 13:11* Then Lot chose him all the plain of Jordan; and Lot journeyed east: and they separated themselves the one from the other.

(9) *Genesis 4:9* And the LORD said unto Cain, Where is Abel thy brother? And he said, I know not: Am I my brother's keeper?

(10) *Luke 6:38* Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.
